General terms and conditions

1. Scope

These general terms and conditions shall apply to the realisation of the corporately organised international conference by the IRM, CDMH and the IIP.

2. Registration

Registrations are considered on a first come, first served basis and will be confirmed at a later date. If the entire conference fee is paid by the due date, the applicant obtains the right to participate at the specified events of the conference. If the applicant does not participate in parts of the conference enrolled and paid for, they cannot demand any financial compensation from the organisers.

3. Cancellation of the definite registration

A cancellation of a confirmed registration must be no later than 4 weeks prior to the start of the conference and will incur an administrative charge of €20.

4. Cancellation, adjournment of events of the conference

In the event of an act of God, natural catastrophe, war, etc. making impossible the realisation of the conference, the organisers have no responsibilities to participants. The conference fee will however be refunded in full.

5. Costs

The conference fee does not include, unless there has been prior agreement, any perquisite to the cover accommodation, travel costs, catering, etc. In signing the registration form, participants undertake to pay the appropriate conference fee in full and on time. If the conference fee is not paid in on time, the organisers are not obligated to allow the participant to join the conference.

6. Participation at events

If specified presenters cancel or certain events within the conference are cancelled (for example, due to speakers being indisposed by illness) there is no requirement that compensation will be made by the organisers.

7. Accountability

The organisers exclude any accountability for any adverse events such as theft during the period of the conference. The participants are responsible for their own insurance coverage.

8. Place of jurisdiction

The place of jurisdiction is Klagenfurt (Austria), the domicile of the Alpen-Adria-University Klagenfurt.
